5. Exhibits may be staged between 10-00am & 11-15am, the hall will then be cleared for judging. **The judge's decision is final.**

Trophies will be presented at 2-45pm after which exhibits may be removed.

1. Daffodils-vase of 3 blooms-trumpet.
2. Daffodils-vase of 1 specimen bloom-trumpet.
3. Daffodils-vase of 3 blooms-large cup.
4. Daffodils-vase of 1 specimen bloom-large cup.
5. Daffodils-vase of 3 blooms-small cup.
6. Daffodils-vase of 1 specimen bloom-small cup.
7. Narcissi-vase of 3 blooms ,multi headed,any 1 variety.
8. Narcissi-vase of 5 blooms,multi headed, any varieties.
9. Double daffodil-vase of 3 blooms- not to be included in any other class.
10. Hellebores-3 blooms.
11. Tulips-vase of 3 blooms-mixed varieties.
12. Polyanthus-vase of 3 stems.
13. Heathers-vase of 3 stems.
14. Flowering shrub-3 stems-any varieties.
15. Pot plant in bloom-pot not to exceed 9 inch dia.
16. Pot plant-foliage-pot not to exceed 9 inch dia.
17. Grape hyacinths-vase of 5 stems.

18. Leeks-3 specimens.
19. Parsnips-2 specimens-trimmed tops.
20. Rhubarb-3 sticks-trimmed tops.
21. Any other vegetable..
